OTTO THE ON-BASE MACHINE

Junior shortstop Doug Otto was brought in from Johnson County Community College to be a big part of the VCU offensive attack.

Over the past five games, Otto is showing just how potent he is with a .667 on-base percentage over that span and a .588 average (10-for-17).

This past weekend against Old Dominion, Otto was even better than that with a .833 on-base percentage and a .750 average (6-of-8).

The Jefferson City, Mo., native is on fire, reaching base in his last nine-plate appearances dating back to his seventh-inning at-bat on Friday against Old Dominion. Since that, Otto has been walked twice, hit twice and notched five hits.

DEANE'S THE DUDE AGAINST UVA

In just three seasons with the Black & Gold Phillip Deane has taken on the role off the starter against in-state rival Virginia.

Tonight's start is his fourth career start out of the five games the Rams have played UVA during his career.

Over that span, he is 0-2 with a 6.39 ERA in 12.2 innings of work.

BREAKING OUT THE WRIGHT WAY

Entering Sunday's finale against Georgia State, senior Justin Wright found himself in a rut. A rut that had him tallying four hits in his previous 28 at-bats.

That's when things turned around for the rightfielder, launching a two-run home run against the Panthers to bring VCU within one and has hit .462 (6-for-13) with two home runs, four RBIs and three runs scored over the past four contests.

MR. 500

With the Rams 11-9 victory in the front end of a doubleheader sweep of Fordham on March 8th, longtime Head Coach Paul Keyes joined elite company, earning his 500th victory.

He currently ranks 43rd on the active all-time winning percentage with a mark of .608 in his 14-plus seasons of work with the Black & Gold.

Keyes came to VCU in 1995 and has helped the Rams capture four CAA Championships and seven NCAA Tournament appearances.

HEAD COACH PAUL KEYES

Paul Keyes says his job doesn't put his business administration degree to much use.

That's not quite true.

Keyes may not be a businessman in the traditional sense but his tenure as head baseball coach at Virginia Commonwealth University makes it clear that he knows the business of baseball.

Going into his 14th season in charge of the Rams, Keyes is only 22 victories away from 500 for his career. VCU is 478-289 under Keyes' guidance. It has been to the NCAA tournament seven times in the past 10 seasons. Keyes is a three-time CAA coach of the year.

"Paul Keyes has built a baseball program at VCU that is second to none," said Norwood T. Teague, VCU's director of athletics. "He is a great teacher, recruiter and mentor to his players. It shows not only in the program's winning legacy but in the loyalty of his alumni as well. With this foundation in place, under his leadership, I can see him taking the program to new heights in the future."

Keyes, a 1984 graduate of Old Dominion University, sounds a little like a businessman when discussing his approach to coaching.

"I always felt I inherently had a pretty good idea of seeing things happen before they happen in games," said Keyes,

who earned a masters in sports administration from the University of Richmond in 1991.

"To be a good coach and a good manager, you have to have that. You have to set your schedule, hire your people, work with them. You have to have a structure and then different systems to deal with the people and the levels you have to deal with. You have to have a good vision, be able to see the whole picture, and be able to adjust and fly by the seat of your pants a little bit."

As an assistant at VCU starting in 1985, Keyes helped lay the groundwork for the program. He served as the pitching and defensive coach. In 1987, VCU went 25-22 for its first winning season in school history. The next year, the Rams made their first NCAA regional appearance. Keyes then went to Vanderbilt University as an assistant and helped the Commodores to an 89-77-2 record over three seasons.

Keyes returned to VCU as head coach in 1995. He became VCU's winningest coach on May 4, 2003 when he picked up his 330th victory.

The past 10 years have been particularly strong. VCU has won 389 games - 45 more than any Division I program in Virginia.

VCU has had 11 straight winning seasons and has won 40-plus games in four of those seasons. His success has been built at home. VCU rosters are always dotted with Richmond-area talent. Five players who were named player of the year by the Richmond Times-Dispatch ended up wearing a VCU uniform.

Eight players have earned All-America recognition in recent seasons - pitcher Matt Burch, shortstop Brandon Inge, pitcher/first baseman Jason Dubois, outfielder Matt Davis, third baseman Anthony Granato, pitcher Justin Orenduff, pitcher Cla Meredith and pitcher Luke Pisker.

Three players have earned freshman All-America honors, including outfielder/first baseman Jared Bolden in 2006.

"Our focuses have always been pitching, defense and speed," Keyes said. "We base everything around speed. We always felt going into regionals, we could beat the larger football-playing schools because we could outspeed them. They can't defense that. It's worked well."

This year figures to be more of the same style.

"I really like our pitching depth," Keyes said. "We had a good young class last year and we've added another one. Like every team we've had, we're going to try and pitch and play defense and try to pressure teams. We'll try to mix the right guys in at the right time and try to be the best team we can be at the end of the year."

Keyes is from Newport News, Va., and he played baseball while a student at Old Dominion. He and his wife, the former Trisha Parham, have three children: Paul Jr., MacKenzie and Kyle.

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY BLUES

As strong as the Black & Gold have been on Fridays (8-3), the opposite happens on Saturdays and Sundays where VCU is a combined 8-14, including losses in eight of the past nine dating back to early in April.

The Rams have lost the last two games of the four of the past five CAA weekend series, with two losses at both Georgia State and Northeastern and back-to-back two loss-weekends at home against George Mason and James Madison.

DASHING DIMINO

The VCU coaching staff knew they were getting a speedy outfielder when Andrew Dimino came to VCU after two years Murray State Community College in Indiana.

Even the coaches may not have thought he was this fast, picking up 25 stolen bases in 40 starts. With his three stolen bases against the Monarchs on Sunday afternoon, he claimed the top spot in the CAA. He also sits first in the conference with .61 stolen bases per game average.

Nationally, Dimino sits 18th in stolen bases per game and 23rd in stolen bases.

He's been just part of the havoc on the basepaths for the opposition with the Rams sitting 41st in the nation in stolen bases (76) and 23rd in stolen bases per game (1.81).

M.L. = MASHING LEFTY

Junior M.L. Morgan's size may not strike fear in the eyes of the opposition, but his bat sure with a .367 average in 49 at-bats, including a jaw-dropping .436 average in conference play.

Morgan has been used as both the DH and the right fielder at times for Coach Keyes. Two weekends ago, serving as the DH against Northeastern, Morgan went 6-for-9 combined in the games on Saturday and Sunday.

SENIOR SENSATIONS

Some experts of college athletics have said that teams can only go as far as their seniors can take them.

If that holds true, the 2009 Rams are in good shape with two of their senior leaders putting up career-best numbers so far this year.

Justin Wright and Carlos Rodriguez, the only two players that have been here for four seasons, have combined for 58 RBIs and 46 runs scored while posting .311 and .228 averages, respectively. Both are career-best numbers for the two veterans.

Wright had six career home runs entering this season and he has already blasted eight on the year, which leads the team. Rodriguez has been "Mr. Clutch" with two-game winning RBI hits, including a dramatic, two-strike, two-out, three-run home run that gave VCU a 10-9 victory over UCF in the second game of the year.

RELIABLE RELIEVING RIGHT-HANDER

In just his first collegiate season, freshman Seth Cutler-Voltz has already become a huge part of the Black & Gold.

Cutler-Voltz has appeared in 22 of VCU's 42 games this year for a total of 37.1 innings pitched. Over that span, the right-hander has tallied 27 strikeouts and a 4.58 ERA, along with a 2-2 record

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A big reason for the Black & Gold's success at the plate this season can be attributed to its patience when it comes to taking pitches.

The Rams hitters have compiled 144 walks and 60 hit-by-pitches in 42 games, that's an average of nearly five free passes per game

Junior Doug Otto has been the leader of the pack with 22 walks on the year, while junior Matt Leskiw is right behind him with 18. Other Rams in double-digit walks include redshirt sophomore Joe Van Meter with 15, junior Andrew Dimino with 14, and seniors R.J. Schenk with 13 and Justin Wright with 11.

DEALER, HIT ME!

One of the easiest, but most painful way of getting on base is getting hit by a pitch. The 2009 Rams know all about that.

VCU currently ranks in the top-50 as a team in hit by pitches with 60 on the season, that's an average of nearly 1.5 hit batsmen per game.

Junior leadoff man Andrew Dimino is the main contributor to that statistic, ranking 38th in the country with 14 HBPs on the year and even better at HBPs per game, ranking 31st in the nation with an average of 0.33 HBPs per game.

The school record for most HBPs is 22 by Jake Anthony in 1999. The 2002 Rams have the most HBPs by a team with 86.

RAIN, RAIN GO AWAY

One of the toughest things about baseball is that you never know if mother nature is going to allow you to play.

Already in 2009, the Rams have dealt with six-plus inches of snow and

heavy rain throughout the month of March forcing two postponements and three cancellations (the whole three-game set versus Stony Brook).

The Black & Gold dealt with that more than ever last year, having a total of nine games cancelled due to inclement weather.

FINALLY, IT'S ALL OURS!

The 2009 campaign will be a historic one for VCU as it will mark the first time in its storied history that the Rams will be the sole tenant of The Diamond.

The Diamond opened its doors in 1985 for the R-Braves and the Black & Gold soon moved in to share the space full-time for the 1986 season.

VCU played six games at the stadium during the 1985 campaign, including the first on April 26th against the Hokies.

FINDING THE DIAMONDS IN THE ROUGH

For the second straight season the Black & Gold went to the junior college ranks to add onto their roster as the Rams welcome Doug Otto (Johnson County CC) and Andrew Dimino (Murray State CC).

Otto became a hot commodity during the 2008 season, finishing with a .423 batting average, 20 doubles, six home runs and 30 stolen bases. His honors went on and on, including NJCAA All-American, Rawlings NJCAA Gold Glove Award winner and NJCAA World Series All-Tournament team.

Dimino was a late addition that the Rams saw a lot of potential in. His speed and athleticism in the outfield will be pivotal in the big outfield of The Diamond, while his ability to get on base will set-up the middle of the Black & Gold's order to drive in runs.

Two of VCU's critical pieces this season came from JUCOs last year, Ian Thomas came from Louisburg JC and R.J. Schenk came from Walters State CC.

NO FREE PASSES HANDED OUT HERE...

Although it was a tough year for the Rams in 2008, the pitching staff showed the constant ability throw strikes as VCU led the CAA and ranked in the top-50 in the country for fewest walks per nine innings.

As a staff, the Rams set a new school record for fewest walks in a season with 142.

In 45 games, the Black and Gold averaged just 3.33 walks per game, ranking 48th in the country with that mark.

Leading the way was the starting pitching for the Rams as Ian Thomas, Cody Eppley and Phillip Deane walked just 57 batters in 193.0 innings pitched

VCU was one of four CAA teams ranking in the top-100 with George Mason ranking 73rd, James Madison 78th and UNC Wilmington 91st.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

For the first time in its CAA history, the Black & Gold saw themselves out of the top three in the CAA Preseason Coaches' Poll.

Usually a mainstay atop the CAA standings, VCU's uncharacteristic 15-30 season dropped the Rams into seventh in the 2009 Pre-season Coaches' Poll, just six votes behind Towson for the sixth and final CAA Tournament.

Good thing the CAA Tournament isn't based on the Preseason Coaches' Poll. In fact, the team that was picked seventh last year (James Madison) was the 2008 CAA Champions.

MORE MORGANS PLEASE...

High school teammates Aaron and M.L. Morgan have shown signs of having breakout years as the former Dinwiddie High School stars have become a part of the everyday Rams lineup with M.L. starting in the outfield and Aaron being used in every crucial bullpen situation.

M.L., a junior, started the last 18 games of the 2008 season, finishing with a .244 batting average with 18 runs scored, four doubles and five stolen bases.

Aaron, a redshirt sophomore, battled back from an arm injury in 2007 to be one of the Rams' best pitchers holding a 1.40 ERA in 25.2 innings of work, while making a team-high 13 appearances. He also ranked third on the team in strikeouts with 33, while walking 13 and holding opponents to just .188 batting average against.

NO NAME CARDS NEEDED HERE...

The 2009 Rams have three sets of high school teammates on their squad with Aaron and M.L. Morgan hailing from nearby Dinwiddie High School, while freshmen Paul Nice and Brent Mikionis hail from Powhatan High School, and the Puerto Rican duo of Richard Gonzalez and Carlos Rodriguez came from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy.

THE BIG 3-0!

Usually 30 is a number that people do not want to see, but when it comes to wins, collegiate baseball coaches love to see 30-plus in the "W" column. Head coach Paul Keyes has gotten accustomed to that number as the Rams have posted 12 30-plus in seasons during Keyes' 14 seasons.

Under Keyes direction, VCU has averaged close to 37 wins and have reached the 40-plus win plateau on four occasions, including a school record 46 wins in both 1998 and 2003.

BREAK? WHAT BREAK?

While most college kids spent their summers on the beach or partying with their friends, junior Robbie Andrews spent his second straight summer earning All-Star recognition in the prestigious Valley League.

Andrews has been a member of his hometown Covington Lumberjacks the past two seasons and have held opponents to under a .250 batting average against and an ERA of just 2.19 of the past two summers.

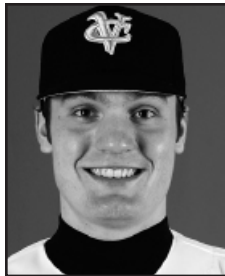
