Prior to an official visit, the following must be submitted to the Compliance Office for approval:

- Recruit ID form (4-Part)
- Travel authorization
- High School Transcripts
- Test Scores
- Official visit Pre-Approval Form
- Apply to NCAA Eligibility Center (must be listed by VCU on IRL)



WHAT YOU AND YOUR RECRUIT NEED TO KNOW

START EARLY



Encourage all prospects to register with the Eligibility Center and initiate the certification process after their **junior year in high school**.



Include NCAA Eligibility Center information in at least one **recruiting letter** to each prospect.



Prospects should answer amateurism questions on Eligibility Center website and sign 10.1 statement after April 1.



Remind all recruits to use the four-digit Eligibility Center code (**9999**) whenever taking the SAT or ACT.

GET ALL THE INFORMATION



Inform the Compliance Office of any prospects with **special circumstances**, such as:

- Multiple high school attendance
- International high school attendance
- Home schooling
- Potential amateurism issues



In case of multiple high school attendance, the Eligibility Center must receive transcripts from **all** high schools.



In case of international high school attendance, the Eligibility Center must receive not only the official transcript in the original language, but also the **English translation**.



In case of potential amateurism issues, notify the Compliance Office so they may be addressed in a timely manner.

FOLLOW UP



Pay careful attention to all **Recruit Rosters** distributed by the Compliance Office. The status of all prospects will appear on this report.



Follow-up with the prospect and his/her high school whenever the Recruit Roster indicates that information is missing (e.g., transcript, test score, etc.), until he/she has been declared a qualifier.



Immediately inform all walk-ons about the Eligibility Center process. A student-athlete who joins the team without final Clearinghouse certification may practice for a period of 14 days (if recruited) or 45 (if not recruited) days from his/her first day of practice. He/she may not compete until final certification as a Qualifier has been obtained and they have been certified as an amateur. If these final certifications have not been obtained by the end of the 14-day or 45-day period, he/she must cease all athletically related activities.
