Kwame Adjeman-Pamboe, George Mason

Adjeman-Pamboe contributed a goal and two assists in leading George Mason to a pair of important CAA victories last week. The senior forward assisted on both Patriots' goals in a 2-0 triumph over Drexel that snapped the Dragons' seven-game unbeaten streak. Adjeman-Pamboe then scored his team-leading fourth goal of the season as Mason knocked off first-place UNC Wilmington 1-0, ending the Seahawks' five-match win streak. Adjeman-Pamboe has three goals and two assists in his past three matches and leads Mason with 12 points for the season.

CAA MEN'S SOCCER ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Steffen Rabben, Old Dominion

Rabben scored both Old Dominion goals in the Monarchs' 2-1 road victory at Drexel last Saturday night. The sophomore forward gave ODU a 1-0 lead in the 29th minute and then tacked on an insurance goal early in the second half. Rabben leads the Monarchs with seven goals and 16 points this season.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

Lot On The Line In Regular-Season Finales: With one game remaining in the regular season, there is still plenty to be determined in the CAA men's soccer race. Nine squads are battling for six spots in the CAA Men's Soccer Championship, with only **UNC Wilmington** and **Old Dominion** having secured berths. Just three points separate third through ninth place and several of those teams have head-to-head matchups. UNCW needs a win or an ODU loss or tie on Friday to earn the #1 seed and the right to host the semifinals and finals. The Monarchs defeated the Seahawks 1-0 earlier this season and own the tie-breaker.

Seven CAA Teams Ranked Regionally: CAA teams again dominated this week's NSCAA South Atlantic rankings with seven squads among the top 10. **William & Mary** was the highest ranked CAA team at #3, followed by **UNC Wilmington** at #4, **George Mason** at #6, **VCU** at #7, **Old Dominion** at #8, **Northeastern** at #9 and **Towson** at #10.

Close Games Continue In CAA Play: Eight of the 12 CAA games were decided by one goal or less and three reached overtime last week, extending a season-long trend of close matches. For the year, 44 of the 60 conference contests (73.3%) have had margins of a goal or less, with 20 going to overtime.

Eight CAA Teams Among Top 100 In NCAA RPI: Eight CAA teams were ranked among the top 100 in the nation according to the NCAA RPI report released on Oct. 26. **William & Mary** led the way at #35, followed by **UNC Wilmington** at #40 and **Towson** at #47. Also among the top 100 were **Northeastern (#64)**, **Old Dominion (#70)**, **VCU (#75)**, **George Mason (#89)** and **James Madison (#100)**.

DELAWARE (3-12-3 overall, 2-7-1 in CAA):

The Blue Hens dropped a 1-0 decision to Northeastern, but snapped a four-game slide by defeating VCU 1-0 in overtime on Saturday. Freshman forward **Andy Streilein** netted the game-winner against the Rams a little over three minutes into overtime for his fourth goal of the year. It was Delaware's first win in seven all-time meetings with VCU. Sophomore goalkeeper **Conrad Rusnak** had a sensational night in the win, making 10 saves and earning his first shutout of the year. Rusnak also stopped three shots against NU and kept the Huskies off the board until the final 10 minutes. Delaware is at Georgia State on Friday.

DREXEL (6-6-5 overall, 4-3-3 in CAA):

The Dragons slipped into a tie for sixth place after losses to George Mason (2-0) and Old Dominion (2-1) last week. The setbacks were the first for Drexel since Sept. 27 and ended a seven-match unbeaten streak. Junior midfielder **Cole Feffer** scored his first career goal against ODU in the 88th minute. Goalkeeper **Alex Reber** got the start against the Monarchs and made eight saves. Drexel was limited to eight shots at Mason and was kept off the scoreboard for the first time since Sept. 21. The Dragons will try to earn a spot in the CAA Tournament when they head to William & Mary on Thursday night.

GEORGE MASON (9-6-2 overall, 5-4-1 in CAA):

The Patriots vaulted into a tie for third place after impressive victories over Drexel (2-0) and first-place UNC Wilmington (1-0) last week. Senior forward **Kwame Adjeman-Pamboe** scored the game-winner against UNCW in the 52nd minute and assisted on both goals in the Drexel victory. It was the team-leading fourth goal of the year for Adjeman-Pamboe, who has contributed three goals and two assists in his past three matches. Freshman **Axel Levery** scored the eventual game-winner versus Drexel just 34 seconds into the match as Mason ended the

Dragons' seven-game unbeaten streak. Freshman **Ryan Garcia** tacked on an insurance goal in the 32nd minute. Junior keeper **Sean Kelley** made four saves in each match and recorded his second and third straight shutouts. Kelley is tied for the CAA lead with seven shutouts on the season. The Patriots travel to second-place Old Dominion on Friday night.

GEORGIA STATE (5-8-4 overall, 1-6-3 in CAA):

The Panthers rebounded from a 4-0 loss to William & Mary to defeat Towson 2-0 on Saturday for their first CAA victory of the season. Senior **Joe DeVito's** first goal of the season in the 73rd minute was the game-winner as he converted a pass from senior **Linus Warendh**. Senior **Eduardo Liza** added an insurance goal in the final minute as he scored for the first time this year on a break-away. Senior keeper **Filipe Carvalho** made six saves against the Tigers and recorded his third shutout of the season and the eighth of his career. Carvalho, who stopped five shots in the setback to W&M, ranks fourth in the CAA with 74 saves. Georgia State hosts Delaware on Friday in its season finale.

HOFSTRA (5-8-4 overall, 4-3-3 in CAA):

The Pride moved into contention for a CAA Tournament berth after tying Towson 2-2 and picking up a key 2-1 road win at James Madison. Hofstra trailed Towson 1-0 with just over three minutes to play, but found the net twice in a 25-second span as sophomore **Demont Mitchell** and **Richard Martinez** each scored their third goals of the season. Hofstra took an early 1-0 lead at JMU on **Eric Rengifo's** first goal of the season. With the game tied, freshman **Brett Carrington** netted the game-winner in the 59th minute. It was Carrington's team-leading seventh goal of the year and his third game-winner. Junior midfielder **Rory McCrea** assisted on both goals at JMU. Freshman keeper **Greg Cumpstone** made eight second-half saves versus the Dukes. He has given up only six goals in his last seven games, three of which have come on penalty kicks. Hofstra travels to first-place UNC Wilmington on Friday.

JAMES MADISON (6-8-3 overall, 3-6-1 in CAA):

The Dukes were beaten 2-0 at UNC Wilmington and 2-1 by Hofstra last week, knocking them out of the race for a CAA Tournament spot. JMU fell behind Hofstra 1-0, but got a game-tying goal from junior **Brian Young** off an assist from senior **Alex Nydal** in the 14th minute. Sophomore goalkeeper **Ken Manahan** made six saves versus the Pride and stopped a penalty shot for the second time this season. The Dukes out-shot UNCW 12-10, but were unable to get on the board. It was the first loss for JMU by more than one goal since a 3-0 season-opening setback to Butler. The Dukes close the season at Towson on Friday afternoon.

UNC WILMINGTON (10-8 overall, 7-3 in CAA):

The Seahawks extended their winning streak to five with a 2-0 triumph over James Madison, but saw it come to an end on Saturday with a 1-0 loss at George Mason. Despite the setback, UNCW clinched a spot in the CAA Tournament and still leads the CAA by two points. Junior **Kirk Hudgins'** first goal of the season early in the second half was the game-winner against JMU. Junior forward **Devan Carroll** added a goal and an assist against the Dukes and continues to lead the league in goals (9) and points (20) for the season. Goalkeeper **Brock Duckworth** made 12 saves last week and posted his fifth shutout of the year. Duckworth has nine wins this season, which is one shy of Brad Knighton's school record. The Seahawks can earn the #1 seed for the CAA Tournament with a win over Hofstra on Friday. UNCW could become just the second team in CAA history to improve 10 spots in the standings after placing 11th a year ago.

NORTHEASTERN (6-4-7 overall, 4-2-4 in CAA):

The Huskies vaulted into a tie for third in the CAA standings after edging Delaware 1-0 and tying William & Mary 1-1 last week. Freshman forward **Mike Kennedy** scored the game-winning goal against the Hens in the 81st minute as he converted a pass from **Nick Lueders**. It was Kennedy's fifth goal of the year. Goalkeeper **Scott Partridge** made four saves and recorded his league-leading seventh shutout of the season. Junior midfielder **Alexander Volk's** goal with just 1:23 remaining in regulation gave Northeastern a 1-1 tie against W&M. It was Volk's second goal of the year and came off an **Eric Dyer** assist. The tie was the seventh of the season for NU, which sets a school record. The Huskies travel to VCU for a crucial match on Thursday night.

OLD DOMINION (9-6-2 overall, 6-3-1 in CAA):

The Monarchs bounced back from a 1-0 setback at VCU to defeat Drexel 2-1 on Saturday. The victory clinched a spot in the CAA Tournament for ODU and kept its hopes alive for the league's regular-season title. Sophomore forward **Steffen Rabben** scored both Monarchs' goals in the victory at Drexel, with the first coming off a **Nane Joseph** assist. Rabben leads ODU with seven goals and 16 points in just 11 matches, and he has scored four goals in CAA play. The Monarchs put eight shots on net at VCU, but were unable to overcome a Rams' goal early in the second half. ODU entertains George Mason in an important league contest on Friday night.

TOWSON (7-5-4 overall, 3-3-4 in CAA):

The Tigers rallied to tie Hofstra 2-2, but were beaten 2-0 at Georgia State last week. Towson dropped to ninth in the CAA standings, but remained alive for a CAA Tournament berth. Junior forward **Tommy Appel-Schumacher** scored both Towson goals at Hofstra on penalty kicks, including one with just 2:30 remaining in regulation. It was the second two-goal game of the season for Appel-Schumacher, who is tied for the team lead in goals with six. Freshman keeper **John Steele** made six saves in the loss at Georgia State and leads the CAA with 94 saves on the season. Towson faces a must-win contest with JMU on Friday.

VCU (8-6-3 overall, 4-4-2 in CAA):

The Rams split their two matches last week, topping Old Dominion 1-0 before losing 1-0 in overtime at Delaware. Sophomore **C.J. Gehin-Scott** scored the game-winner early in the second half against ODU, blasting a one-timer into the net off an assist from freshman **Joseph Haboush**. Senior keeper **Andrew Dykstra** made a season-high eight saves against the Monarchs and recorded his fifth shutout of the season and the 18th of his career. VCU put 10 of its 19 shots on net at Delaware, but were able to score. The Rams, who are eighth in the CAA with 14 points, host third-place Northeastern on Thursday night in a game with big tournament implications.

WILLIAM & MARY (9-5-3 overall, 5-4-1 in CAA):

The Tribe moved into a tie for third in the CAA standings following a 4-0 victory over Georgia State and a 1-1 tie at Northeastern. Junior forward **Andrew Hoxie** scored a pair of goals in the victory at GSU and assisted on **Nat Baako's** goal at Northeastern. Despite being limited to 11 games due injury, Hoxie tops the Tribe in goals (6), assists (4) and points (16). W&M is 7-2-2 with him in the lineup and 2-3-1 without. Baako's goal in the 9th minute at NU was his fifth of the year and he is second on the squad with 14 points. Sophomore keeper **Andrew McAdams** posted his fifth shutout of the year at GSU and now has 12 for his career, which ranks sixth in school history. Sophomore **Alan Koger** tallied his sixth goal of the year versus the Panthers, while senior **Doug McBride** had his first-ever game-winner. W&M hosts Drexel on Thursday in a critical CAA contest.
