VCU Downs Delaware, Towson Too In Wild Weekend

Virginia Commonwealth University took the CAA by storm this past weekend, defeating first-place Delaware in a five-set thriller, as well as Towson in straight sets the following afternoon. The Rams improved to 20-8 on the season and 8-2 in conference. The pair of weekend wins, coupled with last Tuesday's sweep of Liberty, moved Head Coach James Finley into second place on VCU's all-time wins list.

"I don't like to think of any game as more important than another," said Finley, "But this is clearly a great win for our program. I'm really proud of our girls and the determination they showed this weekend."

The Rams continued their recent trend of starting out hot against Delaware, hitting well on the way to a 25-21 opening set victory. The Blue Hens responded with two straight wins, 25-15 and 25-18, respectively. With a strong message from Finley, VCU responded immediately in the fourth set, storming out to a 5-0 lead. The Rams maintained a four or five point lead throughout most of the set before holding on for a 25-23 win. With the momentum almost tangibly shifting to the VCU bench, the Rams posted a .208 hitting percentage on the way

to a 15-10 victory in the decisive fifth set. Junior **Kelsie Clegg** and Freshman **Michala Kvapilova** both had double-digit kills on the night, while Freshman **Marissa Low** led four Rams posting double-digit digs with 26.



Against Towson, Senior **Ivana Rich** led the way with an outstanding .643 hitting percentage and six blocks, while the Rams defeated the Tigers in three sets for their 20th win of the season. Freshman **Michala Kvapilova** claims CAA Rookie Award for fourth time this season.
