THE TIPOFF...

East Carolina takes to the road for the first time this season when it travels to Richmond, Va. for a clash with Virginia Commonwealth. The Rams defeated the Lady Pirates 64-53 last season inside Minges Coliseum after ECU had taken a 26-24 lead at halftime. Current seniors LaCoya Terry and Jasmine Young combined for 28 points in that contest while Quanitra Hollingsworth poured in 24 points to lead all scorers.

ABOUT THE RAMS...

Virginia Commonwealth has started its season 2-1 after picking up wins over Liberty and Tulane. The Rams' lone blemish on their schedule is a 77-65 setback at then No. 4 North Carolina in the second round of the preseason WNIT inside the Dean Smith Center. Hollingsworth currently leads the Rams in scoring with 14.3 points per contest while she also paces her team on the boards, pulling down 5.7 per game. Additionally, Jennifer Lane has dished out nine assists.

ABOUT THE LADY PIRATES...

The Lady Pirates held Presbyterian to 28 percent shooting and just 11 made field goals in a 61-28 win inside Williams Arena at Minges Coliseum on Friday evening. Terry led ECU in scoring for the third-straight contest as she produced 13 points to go along with four rebounds and four steals while sophomore Allison Spivey grabbed eight rebounds, six of which were defensive. Another sophomore, Kim Gay, earned her first start of the season and fourth of her career, scoring eight points and coralling four rebounds.

HEAD COACH SHARON BALDWIN-TENER...

Sharon Baldwin-Tener holds a record of 88-91(.492) at East Carolina and is in her seventh season at the helm the program ... Baldwin-Tener guided the 2006-07 Lady Pirates to their best result since the 1991-92 season, finishing 19-14 and winning their first Conference USA Tournament Championship ... She has led ECU to six consecutive Conference USA Tournament appearances ... Baldwin-Tener has a career record of 157-118 (.571) as a collegiate head coach as she begins her 11th season. The Smyrna, Ga., native is just 17 victories shy of Cathy Andruzzi for second-place on the ECU coaching wins chart.

THE SERIES...

Tonight's contest marks the 21st between the two schools ... ECU leads the all-time series 11-9. The Lady Pirates are 6-4 against the Rams in Greenville, 3-5 in Richmond, Va. and 2-0 at neutral sites.

EAST CAROLINA AGAINST THE CAA...

East Carolina holds an all-time mark of 131-131 (.500) against the current members of the Colonial Athletic Association. The Lady Pirates have squared off against Drexel (1-0), George Mason (24-21), Georgia State (1-0), Hofstra (1-0), James Madison (26-29), Northeastern (1-0), Old Dominion (8-42), VCU (11-9), William and Mary (31-11) and UNC Wilmington (27-19). The Lady Pirates will face UNC Wilmington later this season in December at Trask Coliseum.

EAST CAROLINA AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA...

The Lady Pirates own an all-time mark of 136-145 (.484) against schools in the state of Virginia. ECU has tangled with George Mason (24-21), Hampton (4-0), James Madison (26-29), Longwood (7-2), Norfolk State (1-1), Old Dominion (8-42), Radford (2-1), Richmond (17-24), Virginia (2-1), Virginia Commonwealth (11-9), Virginia State (1-0), Virginia Tech (2-4) and William and Mary (31-11). The Lady Pirates defeated Hampton, 74-58, on Nov. 14 to open the season and will play Virginia in Charlottesville on Dec. 6.

STARTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT...

With the victory over Presbyterian, the Lady Pirates produced the 12th 3-0 start in program history and first since the 1998-99 season. Historically, East Carolina has begun the season with four wins 11 times, with the last time also in the 1998-99 campaign.

DISHIN' IT...

Senior Jasmine Young currently leads the Lady Pirates with 22 assists, an average of 7.3 per game. That mark currently leads Conference USA as Young is looking to turn in the top assist average in the league for the second straight season. Last year, she topped C-USA with an average of 6.2 per contest. Additionally, Young is currently in second-place on the ECU career chart with 525 helpers.

SWISHIN' IT...

Senior LaCoya Terry is off to a blazing start in terms of scoring this season. She currently leads the Lady Pirates with 61 points in three contests, good for an average of 20.4. That mark also leads C-USA and has lifted her career scoring average to 12.3. Terry and Young represent two of the top 10 scorers in C-USA for the 2007-08 season.

2009 C-USA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2009 edition of the league tournament is scheduled for Mar. 5-8 inside Fogelman Arena on the campus of Tulane University. All 12 members of C-USA will compete in the event, with the winner taking the conference's automatic bid into the 2009 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship. Last season, No. 2 seed SMU upset No. 1 UTEP in the UCF Arena to qualify for its seventh appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Mustangs fell to Notre Dame in the first round at West Lafayette, Ind. East Carolina will make its seventh consecutive showing at the league tourney in 2009, looking for its second tournament title in three seasons.

LAST TIME OUT...

GREENVILLE, N.C. - The East Carolina women's basketball team won its third consecutive game to open the season, besting Presbyterian 61-28 Friday night inside Minges Coliseum. The Lady Pirates are now 3-0 overall while the Blue Hose drop to 0-3 on their campaign.

The 28 points allowed ties for the third-fewest in program history, matching an effort in which East Carolina defeated Chowan, 81-28, on Feb. 16, 1974. Lauren Cochran put ECU ahead, 2-0, just 32 seconds into the game when she converted a layup. After the Lady Pirates pushed ahead 4-0, Presbyterian got on the scoreboard when Katlin Moore drilled a three-pointer. The squads would trade points over the next four minutes, as the score favored East Carolina 10-9 at the first media timeout. The Lady Pirates stretched their advantage to 14-9 with just under 10 minutes left in the half, but the Blue Hose ended a scoreless span of 6:19 to cut the deficit to 16-11 as Moore hit a runner in the lane with 6:32 left in the stanza. However, LaCoya Terry scored the next six points for ECU to give her team a 22-11 lead with 2:44 remaining.

In all, the Lady Pirates used an 8-5 run over the last seven minutes of the half to take a 24-14 advantage into halftime. Terry converted a three-point play just 13 seconds into the second half, pushing the Lady Pirate lead to 13. East Carolina would go on to score nine straight points to begin the stanza, assuming a 33-14 advantage and forcing a Blue Hose timeout at the 17:34 mark. Moore then hit a trey for Presbyterian, ending a 3:08 scoreless stretch to begin the half. A layup by Young with 13:32 left in the game gave the Lady Pirates their largest lead of the game to that point, 41-22, and would get larger as ECU scored the next 10 points to take a 29-point advantage. The Blue Hose then ended another six-minute scoring drought when Amanda Mills hit two free throws with just under eight minutes remaining. Still playing solid defense, the Lady Pirates held Presbyterian to just four points the rest of the game, cruising to the 33-point win.

Terry led East Carolina in scoring for the third-straight contest, pouring in 13 while collecting four rebounds and four steals. Spivey was the top performer on the glass for the first time this season, grabbing eight boards, six of which were defensive. With 10 assists, Young produced her first double-digit effort of the year.

The Lady Pirates allowed just 11 field goals as the Blue Hose shot 28 percent on the evening. Homestanding ECU turned in another 40-plus percent mark from the field, firing at a clip of 41 percent. Out-rebounding an opponent for the first time this season, the Lady Pirates held a 47-22 advantage.

WELCOME...TO OUR HOME

East Carolina sports a 259-158 (.621) record in Minges Coliseum since the arena opened in 1975 ... Last season, the squad went 8-7 (.533) at home ... The Lady Pirates are 286-161 (.640) all-time when playing in Greenville, spending their first six seasons at an on-campus site while Minges Coliseum was erected ... The Lady Pirates have been successful on their home court under current head coach Sharon Baldwin-Tener, having accumulated a 52-32 (.619) mark, including a 25-20 (.556) ledger against Conference USA competition.

ROAD TRIP...

East Carolina holds a 263-313 (.457) record away from Greenville since the program began in 1969-70 ... In 2007-08, the Lady Pirates were 4-9 (.308) in road games, and were 1-1 (.500) at neutral sites ... Since Baldwin-Tener took over as head coach, the Lady Pirates are 37-59 (.385) away from Minges Coliseum.

HEATING UP DECEMBER...

The ECU women's basketball team took a trip to Cancun in 2006. This season, the Lady Pirates will again have the opportunity to work on their tans in December as they will travel to the Bahamas right before Christmas and then to Miami, Fla. just after the holiday for in-season tournaments. During that Cancun voyage, ECU fell to nationally-ranked Pittsburgh (70-53) and Detroit (62-57).

HEAD COACH SHARON BALDWIN-TENER

Sharon Baldwin-Tener came to East Carolina University with the best of credentials and the reputation of being a program-maker. In her six years with the Lady Pirates, she has not disappointed. Given the task of resurrecting the women's program, she jumped in immediately and transformed ECU women's basketball into a championship caliber team.

The 2005-06 season saw Baldwin-Tener and her staff continue to build a winner. Not only did the Lady Pirates enjoy their first winning season since 2000-01, the team advanced to its fourth straight C-USA Tournament and posted its first tournament win as a member of the league after defeating UAB. The 17 victories in 2005-06 were the most in school history since the 1991-92 season, when the team finished with a 21-8 mark.

The 05-06 season was not without its highlights as Baldwin-Tener recorded her 50th career win at East Carolina on Feb. 10 after the Lady Pirates defeated Memphis, 74-54. Baldwin-Tener also guided ECU to its 500th school victory with a 69-60 win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 30). For the fourth consecutive season under Baldwin-Tener, the Lady Pirates finished higher in the regular season standings than predicted by the C-USA preseason poll. In 2005-06, East Carolina was tabbed 12th and finished tied for sixth.

Continuing her player development, she molded freshman Jasmine Young and junior transfer Cherie Mills into all-conference players in just one season. Mills finished her first season ranked among the Conference USA leaders in seven statistical categories, and recorded 32 blocks on the year, the most in a single season by a Lady Pirate since 1999. Young, who tallied 153 assists on the year, finished the season ranked 27th in the nation in assists per game. Under Baldwin-Tener's tutelage, Young became the first ECU women's basketball player in school history to earn C-USA Freshman-of-the-Year honors.

In the 2006-07 season, Baldwin-Tener and the Lady Pirates accomplished something that had never been done in East Carolina history; they won the Conference USA Tournament Championship. For the first time in 25 years, the Lady Pirates would be represented in the NCAA Tournament's field of 64. Baldwin-Tener also led ECU to its first-ever bye in the C-USA Championship, securing a third-place regular season finish with a program-best 11 conference wins. The team also enjoyed the fourth-longest winning streak in the country, taking a 10-game unbeaten run into the NCAA Tournament. Another highlight of the 06-07 season was 19 wins, the most since the 1991-92 season.

Senior Cherie Mills and sophomore Jasmine Young repeated as second-team all-conference players. Young also earned C-USA All-Defensive team and All-Tournament team honors. Additionally breaking onto the scene was another sophomore, LaCoya Terry, who was named C-USA Tournament MVP.

A LOOK AT THE 2008-09 LADY PIRATES...

The Lady Pirates have added 11 new faces this season ... Joining the team this season are freshmen Ashley Clarke, Chareya Smith, Jamie Shaw, Jean Best and Crystal Wilson as well as transfers Kelly Smith from West Virginia University and Caitlin Thys from High Point University... Head Coach Sharon Baldwin-Tener also welcomes new assistant coaches Roger Hodge, Adrienne Shuler and Jocelyn Wyatt in addition to director of operations Allison Nichols ... Senior LaCoya Terry returns as the team's leading scorer (15.4 ppg) and rebounder (5.0 rpg).

LADY PIRATES PICKED TO FINISH FOURTH IN C-USA...

Picking up one first-place vote and the fourth-most points in the preseason C-USA coaches poll, East Carolina enters the 2008-09 season as the only program in C-USA that returns two of the league's Top 10 scorers. After earning All-C-USA second team honors and surpassing the 1,000-point scoring mark a year ago, ECU seniors Jasmine Young and LaCoya Terry also both appear on the 2008 All-C-USA Preseason list.

CONFERENCE USA: THE EIGHTH SEASON...

East Carolina University is in its eighth season as a basketball member of Conference USA ... Starting in 2001, the Lady Pirates became eligible to compete for the C-USA Championship after 17 seasons as a member of the Colonial Athletic Association ... In the past seven seasons, the Lady Pirates have made six consecutive appearances in the C-USA Tournament and two years ago finished third in the regular season, their highest ranking since joining the conference ... ECU also recorded its first C-USA Tournament Championship with a 79-70 win over Rice in the 2007 title game inside the Reynolds Center at the University of Tulsa.

HISTORY-MAKERS...

The 2006-07 Lady Pirates made their mark in the East Carolina and Conference USA record books two seasons ago ... Led by coach Baldwin-Tener, the Lady Pirates won the program's first-ever C-USA Championship by defeating Rice 79-70 in the finals ... It marked the first time in 25 years that ECU was represented in the NCAA Tournament ... The Lady Pirates enjoyed a 10-game winning streak, which was the fourth-longest in the nation ... East Carolina won 19 games, the most for the program in nearly 20 years ... For the second season in a row, Cherie Mills and Jasmine Young were named second-team all-conference ... Young was also named to the all-defensive team as well as the all-tournament team ... LaCoya Terry was named the 2007 C-USA Tournament MVP ... Young continued to move up in the ECU record books, moving into 5th all-time in three pointers made (94), 6th in assists (316), and 10th in steals (154).

GREENVILLE, N.C. - The East Carolina women's basketball team won its third consecutive game to open the season, besting Presbyterian 61-28 Friday night inside Minges Coliseum. The Lady Pirates are now 3-0 overall while the Blue Hose drop to 0-3 on their campaign.

The 28 points allowed ties for the third-fewest in program history, matching an effort in which East Carolina defeated Chowan, 81-28, on Feb. 16, 1974.

For the third-straight first half this season, Terry scored in double figures as she netted 10 on 5-for-11 shooting. The senior also cleaned up on the glass, collected four boards. Sophomore Allison Spivey paced East Carolina, however, corralling five rebounds. Senior Jasmine Young distributed the ball well, dishing out five assists, just one off her per game average. The Lady Pirates out-rebounded an opponent in the first half for the first time this campaign, enjoying a 27-15 advantage. ECU also held Presbyterian to just 14 points on 26 percent shooting.

Terry led East Carolina in scoring for the third-straight contest, pouring in 13 while collecting four rebounds and four steals. Spivey was the top performer on the glass grabbing eight boards. With 10 assists, Young produced her first double-digit effort of the year.

The Lady Pirates allowed just 11 field goals as the Blue Hose shot 28 percent on the evening. ECU turned in another 40-plus percent mark from the field, firing at a clip of 41 percent. Out-rebounding an opponent for the first time this season, the Lady Pirates held a 47-22 advantage.
